Again, using the form above, please do not forget to tell us the approximate number of players who would consider taking part in this category. Any holder of a disability certificate issued in their home country is eligible, provided that the disability directly affects and impairs their game performance. The entry to this category will be approved by the organizing committee.

Finally, we are happy to announce that the website of the World Championships is going to be launched by the beginning of November and it will contain all the information you might need at this point (especially about the venue and accommodation).

We look forward to meeting you not only at WTHT tournaments this season but especially in Liberec, Czech Republic, on 16th – 18th June.
