Clashes between World Tour and local tournaments

Information

As the World Tour grows, it is becoming difficult for organisers to comply with Tournament Rule 1.2 ii.

Here is the proposed new Tournament Rule 1.2 ii:

a) No country's national tournaments (at levels 3 or 4) can be arranged on the same weekend as a Super Series tournament.

b) No country's yearly national championship tournament (at level 3) can be arranged on the same weekend as any World Tour tournament within a 1000 km radius of the venue.*

c) Countries' national tournaments (at level 4) can be on any weekend when there is no Super Series tournament, but it is <u>recommended</u> to also avoid weekends when any World Tour tournament is within a 1000 km radius of the venue.*

d) Organisers can ask the ITHF for exceptions to (a), (b) and (c), but these exceptions will only be granted in special circumstances.

e) If a World Tour tournament date is changed after it is announced, organisers with previously scheduled tournament dates that clash will not be expected to change their dates.

The EC suggests that any tournaments breaking this rule should be downgraded to level 6, unless an exception is granted as per (d).
